

Armageddon On Wheels – Figure Eight Bus Race Rules

The figure eight bus race rules are as follows:

- Any 24 to 77 passenger school bus may be used.
- Must remain stock appearing.
- Re-enforced front bumper is allowed. No bigger than 6" diameter pipe or angle iron.
- Seat belt must be operable, 5-point harness recommended but not required.
- Helmet, goggles, gloves, long pants and long-sleeved shirts mandatory.
- Foam neck brace recommended but not required.
- Steel toe boots or shoes required, no sandals or tennis shoes.
- Battery must have protective covering and be strapped down. (Plumber's tape works well)
- All glass must be removed besides front windshield.
- All breakable components outside of the bus must be removed i.e. headlights, taillights, plastic reflectors, mirrors, etc.
- Coolant must be drained and replaced with water.
- Must have driver's side window net. (Seatbelts and self-tappers work well)
- Must have a number on the bus, no vulgar or obscene lettering.
- No driver's door/ compartment side hits, violators will be disqualified.
- No deliberate hits.
- This is a race not a demolition derby.
- No fuel enhancer's, nitrous, etc.

We will be doing a nicest looking bus contest in the beginning which the audience will vote for the nicest looking bus, the winner will receive a prize. All outside buses must be removed within 14 hours of the show concluding because, there is another event coming to the fairgrounds the next day.
